DATE: SATURDAY, JUNE 17, 2017

LOCATION: CASCADE RESERVOIR, CASCADE, IDAHO, CITY RAMP

PAYOUT: TOP 10 PLACES (ALL OPTIONS: 100% PAYOUT) BIG FISH: (1 PLACE)

OFF LIMITS: 12:01 AM, MONDAY, JUNE 12, 2017 TO TAKE OFF SATURDAY, JUNE 17, 2017. Rules apply to all contestants, including boats used in tournament. **No tournament angler or boat is permitted on tournament water during off limits dates.**

PRE-TOURNAMENT MEETING: Friday, June 16, 2017, 7:30pm CASCADE CITY RAMP

TOURNAMENT TIME: Launch at safe light. Prior to Live Well and Rod Locker checks, Saturday, June 17, 2017

WEIGH-IN TIMES: First Flight-4:00pm. 2nd Flight-4:15pm.

FISH LIMIT: FIVE (5) fish limit with minimum length of 12"

BOAT DRAW: Boat draw will be Thursday, June 14, 2017 at Golden Wheel Drive-In, 11100 Fairview Ave.

Boise, Idaho, 10:00 AM. LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED BUT WILL GO OUT LAST WITH FIRST FLIGHT CHECK IN.

CANCELLATION/WITHDRAWAL: NO REFUND OF PAID TOURNAMENT FEES WITH FINALIZATION OF BOAT DRAW.

SPORTSMANSHIP: Any contestant, who displays poor sportsmanship, violates tournament rules or is ticketed for violations of State Fish and Game laws and/or State Laws will be disqualified. Good sportsmanship and fair play should be directed at non-tournament anglers who may be on the lake during the period of tournament in addition to other tournament participants.

SAFETY: Safe boating conduct and all safety precautions must be observed at all times by all contestants. All contestants must have a life vest and other safety equipment as specified by the Coast Guard. Life vests must be worn and the kill switch attached to the driver when the internal combustion engine is running. Boat breakdown: Turn Motor Band to orange side to notify other boaters HELP is needed in your boat. It is highly recommended to accept first offer of assistance.

TACKLE: SPINNING ROD & REELS ONLY, artificial lures may be used. No prepared or live bait, other than pork type strips or rinds, is permitted. Only rods and reels are permitted. Only one rod may be in use and in the water at any time, however, any number of rigged rods may be in the boat for substitute purposes. Electrical and mechanical devices, such as depth meter, color-C-elector, thermometers, and oxygen meters may be used. Landing nets are permitted. **ALL BOATS MUST BE EQUIPPED WITH A LIVE WELL AERATED PUMP CAPABLE OF KEEPING A LIMIT OF BASS ALIVE.**

PERMITTED FISHING WATERS: This tournament has a no touch rule. All fishing must be done from a boat. All contestants must leave and return to the tournament launch point within tournament hours. **Lake Cascade water boundaries apply no fishing beyond the S or fishing bridges.**

CHECKING IN: Tournament boats must check in with official check point. **This is mandatory for participant safety.**

PENALTIES: Contestants who have not checked in at the official weigh-in check point on time will be penalized one (1) pound of weight for every minute of tardiness. Contestants who check in ten (10) minutes late will lose all credit for the day's catch. Boat and/or motor trouble are not exceptions. Anyone weighing in a fish smaller than twelve (12) inches will lose all credit for the day's catch. Fish will be measured mouth closed on a FLAT board. Fanning of the tail is permitted. No more than five (5) fish are permitted in boat live well at all times. Boats with more than five (5) fish will be disqualified for that day's contest. Big fish must be alive to qualify as big fish. A finding that a contestant and/or boat were on tournament water during off limits dates will result in disqualification.

ALL VISIBLE FISH MUST BE CAUGHT IN THE MOUTH. NO SNAGGED OR FOUL HOOKED BASS ALLOWED.

SCORING: Scoring will be determined by the total weight of each team's catch. Tournament limit will be five (5), twelve (12) inch or longer fish per team. An 8 oz. deduction penalty will be assessed for each dead fish weighed in. In case of a tie, largest single fish among contenders will determine the winner. In case of a tie for largest fish, the highest team weight determines the winner.

COMPLAINTS: Complaints must be submitted to the TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR in writing no later than 30 minutes after final weigh-in. Decisions of the tournament officials are final.

ALCOHOL/NARCOTICS: Consumption and/or possession of alcoholic beverages and/or narcotics are prohibited while the boat is in the water. Narcotics with medical prescription excluded. Violations will result in disqualification.

STARTING POSITIONS: NO trading of starting positions.

MOTOR BANDS: Motor Bands are required and will be available to anglers before tournament starts with a \$20 deposit. Deposit to be refunded on return of the motor band at weigh-in.

POLYGRAPH TESTING: Polygraph testing procedures per BASS tournament rules will be followed. Contestant winnings may be withheld pending outcome of polygraph test results at discretion of Tournament Officials.

RULES: This event will follow BASS tournament rules if additional references and clarifications are required.
