

2017 TBF Semi-Final

Montana VS Idaho

This is The Bass Federation (TBF) Semi-Final event which is held annually and alternating from Idaho to Montana. Competitors have gone through a rigorous qualifying process to earn spots to fish on these teams to compete for money, prizes and ultimately to qualify the top boater and co-angler from each state to move on to compete at the TBF National Championships representing their respective host states. Ultimately competitors have a chance to earn spots to compete in National Pro Events and the Living the Dream Package.

Qualified tournament anglers from Idaho and Montana will meet at Noxon Reservoir where the competition will be based out of the town of Trout Creek, Montana September 9th and 10th 2017. This event is held at the beautiful Lakeside Inn & Resort on the shores of Noxon Reservoir located in the small town of Trout Creek. Noxon Reservoir is a 38-mile-long reservoir on the Clark Fork river which spans from the town of Thompson Falls North to the Noxon Dam. Trout Creek is located midway down the reservoir.

Noxon Reservoir is known as a premier Bass fishery that is excellent for both Large Mouth and Small Mouth Bass. Noxon Reservoir holds the current state record Large Mouth Bass at 8.8 lbs. Noxon is also known for producing Small Mouth Bass in the 6 lb. + range. Anglers will be trying to catch the largest limit by weight of 5 bass of either species with a minimum length of 12".

Daily weigh-ins will take place on the lawn behind the Lakeside Inn & Resort with beautiful views of the Noxon Reservoir and Mountains in the back ground.
