U.A.E. Rules 2012

1. Sportsmanship: Any contestant who displays poor sportsmanship at any qualifying event or Ultimate angler Event including, but not limited to the following will be disqualified and forfeit all entry fees. A violation of rules, ticketed for violation of any Fish & Game State or Federal Laws, and fair play to be directed towards any non-tournament anglers on the lake during the period of all tournaments as well as towards tournament anglers.
2. Safety: Safe boating conduct and all safety precautions must be observed. Everyone fishing the tournament must have a life vest and all other safety equipment as specified by US Coast Guard Regulations. Life vest must be worn and kill switch attached to the driver at all times when the big motor is running.
3. Tackle: Only artificial lures may be used. No prepared or live bait, other than pork strips or rinds, are permitted. A live well or suitable substitute to maintain healthy, live fish is required.
4. Permitted fishing waters: No touch rule will apply in fishing waters. No fishing in launch ramp cove. Narrows speed limit as described on permit must be followed at all times.
5. Check-in: All boats must check in at official check in point which will be announced at the boaters meeting Friday night.
6. Penalties: Contestants who have not checked in at the official check point on time will be penalized one (1) pound of weight for every one minute of tardiness. (Official time will be announced at blast off) A boat checking in ten (10) minutes or more late will be disqualified. Boat and/or Motor troubles are no exceptions. Any bag weighing in a fish smaller than 12 inches will be disqualified. Fish will be measured on a FLAT BOARD. Fish must be alive to qualify as big fish. A bag of more than five (5) fish limit will be disqualified.
7. Scoring: Scoring will be determined by the team total weight consisting of five (5) fish total. A .25 pound penalty will be assessed for each dead fish weighed in. In case of a tie with total weight the team with the single largest live fish will be determined the winner. In case of a tie for big fish the team with the largest total weight will be determined the winner. If ties still exist after these measures it will be determined a tie and any prizes will be split 50/50.
8. Off Limits: Any contestant determined to have violated the off limits dates and times will be disqualified.
9. Complaints: Complaints must be submitted in writing to designated tournament official no later than 30 minutes of official weigh-in or prior to presentation of awards, whichever comes first.
10. Alcohol: No alcohol consumption will be allowed during tournament hours.
11. Motor Bands: Motor Bands are required and will be provided at the boaters meeting.

12. This is a team event. Teams must be named on first event entry form and compete at this event as such.
13. Qualifications require entry and competition in 4 or more TBF or IBFN qualifiers, and/or major event opens (identified on entry form) during the calendar year. (No entries will be accepted without documentation of participation from event organizers with completed entry form and money.)
14. There will be NO refunds if Qualifications are not met. The burden of proof is up to each competitor. Tournament officials will not be responsible to research disputes.
15. Tournament officials will be a culmination of IBFN/TBF club representatives.
16. All Rules will be enforced as written in this document.
17. Decisions made by tournament officials will be final – NO EXCEPTIONS.
18. There will be off limits Monday prior thru tournament morning.
19. Boaters will be required to show proof of \$300,000 active liability insurance policy.
