

# Instructions For Event Directors

The form attached is designed to eliminate your need to collect a bunch of paperwork at your events.

It became evident that last year's design was a bit of a hassle for tournament directors running these opens. As we looked at ways to improve we came up with this simple reporting form.

1. Simply document the team names ( 1<sup>st</sup> initial & last names ), amount paid, and how it was paid.
2. Put the money & list in the mail to: Ultimate Angler c/o Chris Rambough

3. Both the IBFN & TBF websites will carry a running list of teams and the events they have paid for so the teams can keep track easier.
4. You are REQUIRED to send this money & list immediately following the event. Having multiple people holding entries and money until the end of the year created quite an issue for the U.A.E. event coordinators last year !!!
5. If your event is not listed on our Websites anglers will be directed to contact you for an explanation of where there money is...

Payouts will be 1 in 5 boats
